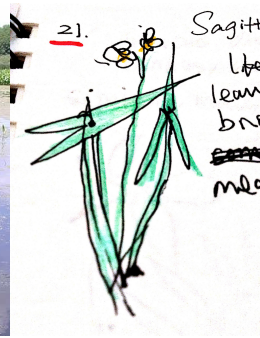


5. Sagittaria latifolia (L8) broadleaf arrowhead Alismataceae

Type:herbaceous perennial

Height and spread:M & Medium(0.5-1m/0.1-0.5m)

Leaf & flower size:30cm/4cm

Bloom time:July to September
