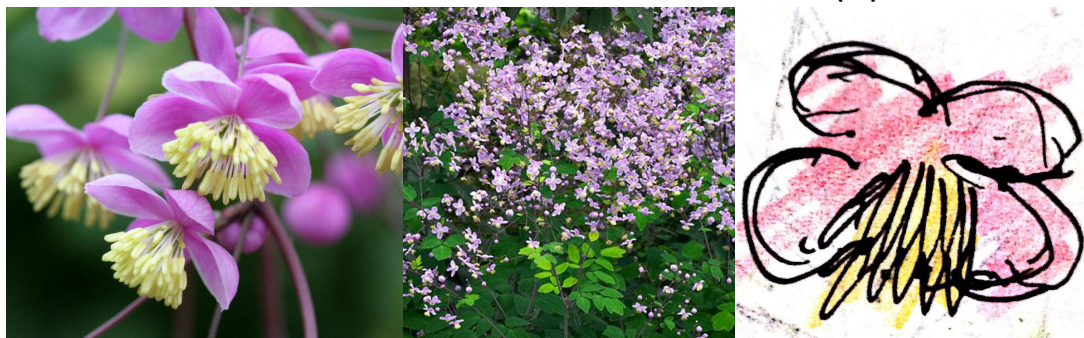


260. *Thalictrum rochebruneanum* lavender mist Ranunculaceae(L7)



Basic ID *cherry like flower color with yellow inside*

Zone:4 to 7

Type:herbaceous perennial

Height and spread:6 ft/3 ft

Bloom time:July too September

Evergreen/deciduous:deciduous

Flower & Fall color: Lavender-purple

Leaf arrangement/Foliage:lacy, fine-textured, bluish-green, pinnately compound, columbine-like foliage
