- compare short story to *Chronicle*, focus on any similarities in **theme**, **motif** (literary features), **symbolism**, etc.



# Bystander Effect

- The probability of help is inversely related to the number of bystanders.
- Factors: ambiguity, cohesiveness, diffusion of responsibility
