I.O. ISSUES

- facilitation: to make easy

- **go beyond** discussing how context and culture is important in general: **be specific**
- discuss how your cultural/contextual understanding has developed and how this development changes/ deepens your interpretation and understanding of SPECIFIC characters, events, etc. in the novel

INTRODUCTION


- Published in 1954, one of his earlier works
- Uta-jima fictional island modelled after Kamishima Island





YUKIO MISHIMA 1925-1970

- traditional, right-wing related to elite Japanese families
- idealized the *bushido* (way of the warrior) and *Sengoku* values (15-17th C. warring states period)
- committed the *seppuku* (ritual suicide) at 45 years old



YUKIO MISHIMA 1925-1970

• Immediately before his suicide, he addressed the soldiers of the Japan Self-Defence Forces to inspire the restoration of the emperor's power - was not successful
