 - 4. Research a dance company or dance group that specializes in this specific dance style inside or outside of Canada (link to a dance video and website required) today.
 - 5. Find a video that explains the choreographer's ideas or its legacy to the dance world.
 - 6. Which influences from this dance pioneer remain today? Where can they be found?
 - 7. Give the link to a dance video of this style that you can see yourself being able to learn today. Explain why you chose this video.
 - 8. Expand on what you like and dislike about this way of moving.
- c. Research project must be written on the computer and include a bibliography
- d. The assignment should be 800-1000 words in length.
