

## **210: FIELD EXPERIENCE RULES:**

1. DO NOT be late. Arrive 20-30 min early. Allow for parking, late buses, skytrain breakdown.
2. DO NOT PARK in “principals” parking spot when late. Read signs where to park.
3. If going to be late, TEXT me to give me heads up. Accidents, traffic jams, etc
4. DO NOT bring coffee. Eg story of coffee knocked by HS student that spilled onto clarinet.
5. DO NOT bring extra “stuff.” BRING bare minimum. Instrument, music, purse – insurance – theft is grey area whether covered
6. DO NOT shake hands unless other adult extends hand shake as professionals avoid.
7. DO NOT share mouthpieces. High vigilance on hygiene, germs.
8. DO NOT physically touch students unless “Is OK if I move your arm to show flute posture.”
9. DO NOT give personal email, cell phone numbers, FB to students under 18 years old.
10. DO sign into the school office or find out procedure for guests.
11. DO wear professional clothes – no jeans unless “jean day.”
12. DO bring business cards – many pick up private musical gigs
13. DO bring your own instrument to play.
14. DO tell students to use professional name, “Mr/Ms.” (first name ok for small clinics)
15. DO be positive and enthusiastic
16. DO be patient. Students take twice as long as to setup, move, tear down, etc.
17. DO take leadership with I statements. “I need it quiet, I need your patience, I need focus.”
18. DO be gracious. “THANKS for excellent lesson. THANKS for being patient. THANKS
19. DO wash hands often. Germs are everywhere in schools.
20. DO have a smile. 😊 It works. Students love happy young teachers.
