Subject: Review of "Prisoner's Dilemma" Definition

I have reviewed your definitions assignment on the "Prisoner's Dilemma". I thoroughly enjoyed learning something new outside of my field and your explanation was concise and easy to understand. Thank you for your great work! I have offered suggestions below to improve your work:

Organization: It appears that you have missed an introduction to the assignment indicating the criteria and objective of the assignment. I suggest including this introduction upon editing as it would help the reader to anticipate what you will be defining, as well as, the purpose of the assignment. You may also want to underline your "Examples" section and "References" sections to keep your assignment consistent, given that your definitions sections are all underlined.

Writing: I would suggest revising your parenthetical definition as it is more like a sentence definition rather than a clarifying phrase in parenthesis. For example, "Unknowingly, two friends are deciding between the two same schools to attend next year, encountering a prisoner's dilemma (each person picks what's best for his or self)." With those unfamiliar with the term EU, you should probably have European Union in parenthesis the first time so that it is clarified when you use it later. You might want to include one more reference, such as a textbook or another website, given that the assignment calls for no fewer than three outside references.

Visual: Your choice of visual was striking and drew my attention. It was also easy to follow, given the colours and labelling of the diagram. You may wish to include a figure caption to explain your visual which could include your sentence definition. For example, "Figure 1. Prisoner's Dilemma diagram, outlining the choices and consequences of prisoners' A and B."

Example: As a reader unfamiliar with the term, I find that your choice of a real-world example is quite useful; however, I find it slightly difficult to relate it back to your visual and placing what consequences go where. I recommend annotating your example, relating it to your visual or creating a new figure based on your scenario.
