

Comprehension Booklet Checklist



Lit Circle Sheet: Include a quote, a thick and thin question, a connection, one transformation, two new words, one prediction and a visualization.



Title Page: Get your creative juices flowing by developing a title page that displays something significant from your favourite moment of the book (make sure to include the title of your book). Colour your illustration using pencil crayons and fineline in blue or black ink.



YOUR CHOICE! For each book choose one of the following (each book you must choose a different activity):

****Remember to be creative and colourful!! Everything should be finelined and good copy****

1. **Write a Diary.** Choose a significant event from your novel. If you were the main character of this story, how would you write about that day?
2. **Compose a Song.** Write lyrics (or adapt a song) to recite the events of the story.
3. **Design the Front Page of a Newspaper.** Write a short news story describing the events of the novel. Use catchy headlines and write teasers to cover your front page.
4. **Design a Comic Strip.** Illustrate a comic that shows a major event in the story—or adapt the whole novel into a comic strip (Must Be At Least 8 Panels)
5. **Build a Character's Dossier.** You're a spy reporting on a chosen character. Compile a secret file complete with all the information needed on your character. Don't forget the photo.
6. **Get Creative.** What do you want to do? Check with a teacher before you being.

***IMPORTANT*:**

- You are only required to do this for 3 of the 4 books that you are expected to read. However, the more you do the better!
