- **1. Write a Diary.** Choose a significant event from your novel. If you were the main character of this story, how would you write about that day?
- 2. Compose a Song. Write lyrics (or adapt a song) to recite the events of the story.
- **3. Design the Front Page of a Newspaper.** Write a short news story describing the events of the novel. Use catchy headlines and write teasers to cover your front page.
