#### ASIAN ELEPHANT COMPASSIONATE CONSERVATION FIELD COURSE – THAILAND Course: LFS 302 D (6 credits)

Students will participate in an on-going research program that is studying the behaviour, social dynamics, bioacoustics, and food ecology of a family re-wilded Asian elephants. Students will hike into a pristine bamboo and tropical evergreen forest to observe these elephants, assess the forest habitat, and survey other wildlife. Students will be accompanied by elephant guardians at all times when in elephant habitat. Students will be accompanied by elephant guardians at all times when in elephant habitat. Students will be accompanied by the local village. In addition to research activities, students will have the opportunity to participate in local Karen activities, such as rice planting, foraging for native vegetables, animal tracking, language lessons in Thai and Karen, fabric weaving, bamboo crafts, as well as traditional meal preparation.

#### **Program requirements**

In addition to completing the 4-week course, to earn credit, students must complete a final written, research project based on on-site lectures and data collection.
