Co-op

What: Paid work terms to gain experience in your field

Options: Food science, clinical research, government, field studies, plant and soil research, etc.

When: Apply in your 3rd year by October 7

- Co-op placements are typically held in three annual work terms: Fall (Sept – Dec), Winter (Jan – Apr) and Summer (May – Aug).

How: [Apply online](#) through science co-op

Application requirements:

- Have a minimum average of around 68%
- Be a full-time UBC (Vancouver) student in good academic standing in mathematics, English and the sciences

Minors

What: A minor involves taking courses in LFS (minimum of 18 upper-level credits) outside your main area of specialization, or in another faculty

Options: Arts, Commerce, Fermentations, Science, Sustainable Food Systems

When: Apply in your 2nd year

How: [Apply online](#) on the LFS website by March 31

Application requirements:

- An average of at least 68% in each of the previous two years
- Each minor has different requirements posted on the [UBC Calendar](#)

Honours

What: The SAGE and AABI Honours options are intended for exceptional students with an interest in research

- a minimum of 132 credits and an honours thesis

Options: choose a supervisor and area of research for your thesis

When: Apply in your 2nd year

How: Apply through LFS Student Services by March 31

Application requirements:

- A minimum cumulative average of 75% is required for admission to the Honours option
