Visa Requirements:

If you are not a UK Citizen or a national of the Republic of Ireland and you do not already hold an immigration permission that entitles you to study in the UK you will need to apply for a visa to study at the RVC.

Tests and questionnaires before interview

Applicants are required to submit a work experience questionnaire (WES), detailing work experience, when applying. All applicants (except North American students applying through VMCAS) must complete and submit a WES by 22 October

Academic Requirements:

Undergrad -

Applicants from Canada are admitted to the University of Edinburgh with a range of national qualifications, the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma or A Levels.

British Columbia

Certificate of Graduation with five Grade 12 subjects at 80%, with 85% in required subjects for all degree programmes in Science/Engineering/Medical Sciences. Where Maths is a required subject this must be Calculus.

For Biomedical Sciences & Medical Sciences, five grade 12 courses, including Biology and Chemistry; three at 80% and Biology and Chemistry at 85%.

For all degree programmes in the College of Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences, the Certificate of Graduation with at least five suitable Grade 12 Subjects at 80%.

Postgrad -

You must have graduated from a recognised Canadian university and have successfully completed at least four years of study.

Entry requirements will vary, depending on the intended programme of study.

Minimum entry requirements are 3.25 on a 4.0 GPA scale, 7.0 on a 9.0 GPA system or a lettered grade of B+ overall.
