It is worth noting that high school students are eligible to apply for any of our undergraduate programmes with the qualifications listed below, including Veterinary Medicine (5-year) which in the UK is traditionally studied straight from high school/secondary school.

College students attending a US or Canadian university must apply through the VMCAS application system and will be considered for both the four-year Graduate Accelerated BVetMed and the five-year BVetMed programme

Overall GPA and Science GPA of at least 3.4 but all applications are given due consideration.

Prerequisite classes:

Required at upper level (e.g. 300-400 level):

At least 9 upper-level semester credits in Biology/Biological Science. Examples include but are not limited to, 300+ or equivalent in the following: Immunology, Anatomy/Physiology, Parasitology, Histology, advanced Microbiology or advanced Genetics.

Also required (3 semester credits each):

Biology (e.g. Principles of Biology, Introductory Biology)

Mathematics

Physics

Anatomy/Physiology

Organic Chemistry

Biochemistry

Visa Requirements:

If you are not a UK Citizen or a national of the Republic of Ireland and you do not already hold an immigration permission that entitles you to study in the UK you will need to apply for a visa to study at the RVC.
