

RESEARCH SUPERVISORS NEEDED FOR 4-WEEK PERIOD IN VANCOUVER

We are looking to hire a research supervisor for a nutrition study led by Dr. David Hammond in the School of Public Health & Health Systems at the University of Waterloo. The study involves completing exit surveys with restaurant patrons in four cities, including Vancouver. The purpose of the study is to examine patterns of eating out, food consumption and awareness of nutritional information in restaurants.

The research supervisor position will involve a 2-day training session in Waterloo in early September and 3-4 weeks of fieldwork in Vancouver. The supervisor will coordinate a team of approximately 15 research assistants and will be responsible for overseeing data collection in Vancouver and coordinating with the Project Manager at the University of Waterloo.

Qualifications:

We are looking for responsible, organized individuals who have strong communication and problem-solving skills, excellent attention to detail and the ability to manage a team. Previous survey research experience is preferred. Applicants must have a valid driver's licence.
