- 10. Adhere to the regulations of the BC Chicken Marketing Board and other governing agencies.
- 11. Recordkeeping.
- 12. Basic maintenance and providing access to repair personnel for two rental houses.
- 13. Liaison with Administration Office as it pertains to expenses, payroll, contracts, employees, etc.

The successful candidate should have experience in Poultry/Broiler Growing, however someone with other poultry experience may be considered.

- 2-5 years of experience in poultry/broiler growing.
- Effective people management skills.
- Ability to carry out manual duties including lifting approximately 50 lbs.
- Ability to read & write in English.
- Must have valid class 5 BC Drivers licence.

- Must be able to work in a hot environment, up to 35° C for 2 hours at a time.
