Attention: Director of Scholarships, Awards and Bursaries

The Keith Gilmore Foundation, established in 1987, offers up to \$34,000 in scholarships to worthy applicants enrolled in secondary and post-secondary education in the fields of agriculture, agricultural journalism and veterinary medicine. Students must be Canadian citizens but can apply to a University or College outside of Canada.

The following scholarships are available and awarded before September 1st of each year;

- a) **KGF Prize for Beef Cattle Innovation – Application Due June 1, 2019**
Up to two \$10,000 scholarships are offered to individuals in senior undergraduate (entering the final year), veterinary, or post-graduate studies in advanced studies leading to a career in the beef industry. Areas of study are broadly defined but include areas such as animal science, range management, forage and feeding, genetics, communications and business.
- b) **Hereford Youth Scholarship – Application Due June 1, 2019**
Up to four \$ 2,500 scholarships are offered to individuals in ongoing studies in any undergraduate program leading to a career related to the livestock industry. Applicants must be a current or past member of Canadian Junior Hereford Association (CJHA) or have a commercial connection to the Hereford cattle breed, be registered for ongoing studies in an undergraduate program at a college or university (entering into the second, third or fourth year at the time of receiving the award) in any program that leads to a career in in the livestock industry.
- c) **Future of the Breed Scholarship – Application Due May 15, 2019**
Up to four \$1,000 scholarships are offered to active members of the CJHA. The applicant must be currently entering a post-secondary program or in their final year of high school as of January 1st, 2018 with the intention of entering a full-time post-secondary program of their choice at the time the award is received. Applications must be postmarked no later than May 15th of the year of application.
