Student ambassadors (one from the Eastern region and one from the Western region) will assist members of the CSAS Executive to promote student attendance and engagement and manage events at the annual meeting. This includes attendance at the CSAS Annual General Meeting, Awards Banquet, and Student Mixer and participation in the CSAS Executive Board Meeting as a non-voting member.

Award amount:

\$1000.00 towards expenses for travel to the 2019 CSAS-ASAS Annual Meeting and Trade Show. Attendance fees for CSAS AGM, Awards Banquet and Student Mixer will also be covered.

Eligibility:

- Registered CSAS member (proof required)
- Registered in an MSc or PhD at a recognized Canadian university
- Registered and attending the 2019 ASAS-CSAS Annual Meeting and trade show
- Attendance at the CSAS Executive Board Meeting (held the day before the conference starts in Austin, TX), the CSAS AGM, CSAS Awards Banquet, and CSAS Student Mixer is mandatory

Application:

- Proof of membership (CSAS membership number) and student status (attestation by supervisor/department head)
- Students please send an application letter (max. 250 words) describing your background and why the role of CSAS Student Ambassador is important to you
