The Gui farm was established by Gary and his family in 2021. It is being developed as a 40-acre regenerative food forest to produce high-quality, diverse, and healthy foods. Several hundred nut and fruit trees and bushes have been planted, along with grains and vegetables for soil protection. Farm infrastructure, including a barn and a kitchen, are in the process of being built. The property is equipped with running water, a bathroom, washroom and an RV. The goals of this growing season are to maintain 400 trees currently planted, plant an additional 300 trees and bushes, finish deer fencing, prevent erosion along ravine, design and build the water reserve system, and eradicate brambles from south side of the ravine and around the borders. Students who apply would be welcome to provide input or design a project of their own interest on the property.
