HOUSING

Tecnológico de Monterrey – Campus Querétaro offers the opportunity to live with a host family. The students would be able to experience the Mexican culture, improve their Spanish and enjoy Mexican life from a closer perspective.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Each participant must provide evidence of holding a valid health insurance policy with comprehensive coverage in the host country for the duration of the academic period in which the student will be involved. Students at ITESM Campus Querétaro are obliged to purchase the health insurance policy offered by Campus Querétaro; this insurance will include coverage for repatriation of remains and Civil liability.

ORIENTATION SESSION

Tecnológico de Monterrey Campus Querétaro will give a welcome orientation session. During the orientation session, different practical topics will be exposed: City guide, safety issues, emergencies and medical services, sightseeing, shopping, restaurants, campus regulations, program generalities, etc.
