To qualify for this nonrenewing scholarship award, the student must meet the following criteria:

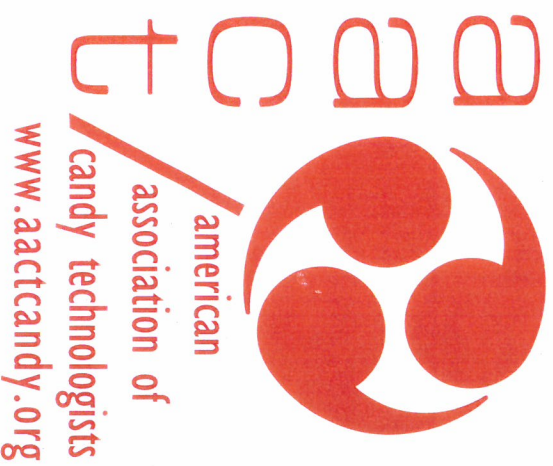
- College sophomore, junior or senior status in 2017/2018.
