NOTE

The verb être is the only exception to our recipe and is conjugated as follows:

j'étais nous étions tu étais vous étiez il/elle était ils/elles étaient

INGREDIENTS

- An infinitif verb (dévorer)
- One first person singular subject, je
- Imparfait endings (ais, ais, ait, ions, iez, aient)
- Cheese knife
- Cheese board
- Saucisson
- Grapes or Olives
- 2 sprigs of Rosemary
- Fresh baguette

PROCEDURE

- Pick your favourite infinitif verb
- We've chosen to work with **dévorer**
- Score your verb gently, then add your rosemary sprigs and bake in the oven at 400°
- While dévorer is baking, take your *je* from the fridge and set it aside
- Let *dévorer* melt into the présent de l'indicatif conjugated with *nous*
- You should be left with a nice and creamy *nous dévorons*
- Next, separate your verb in half, you should be left with the stem *dévor* and the ending *ons*
- With your cheese knife, cut out your **ons**, it is no longer needed
- You're now ready to use your *je* and your imparfait ending, *ais*
- Place *je* first on your cheese board, then add the completed verb, *dévorais*
- Decorate your cheese board with your saucisson, fresh baguette, and olives or grapes as desired
- Voilà, you've baked the imparfait!
