Ophelia is devastated. Swearing to never love another man again, she spends the rest of her life in a nunnary.

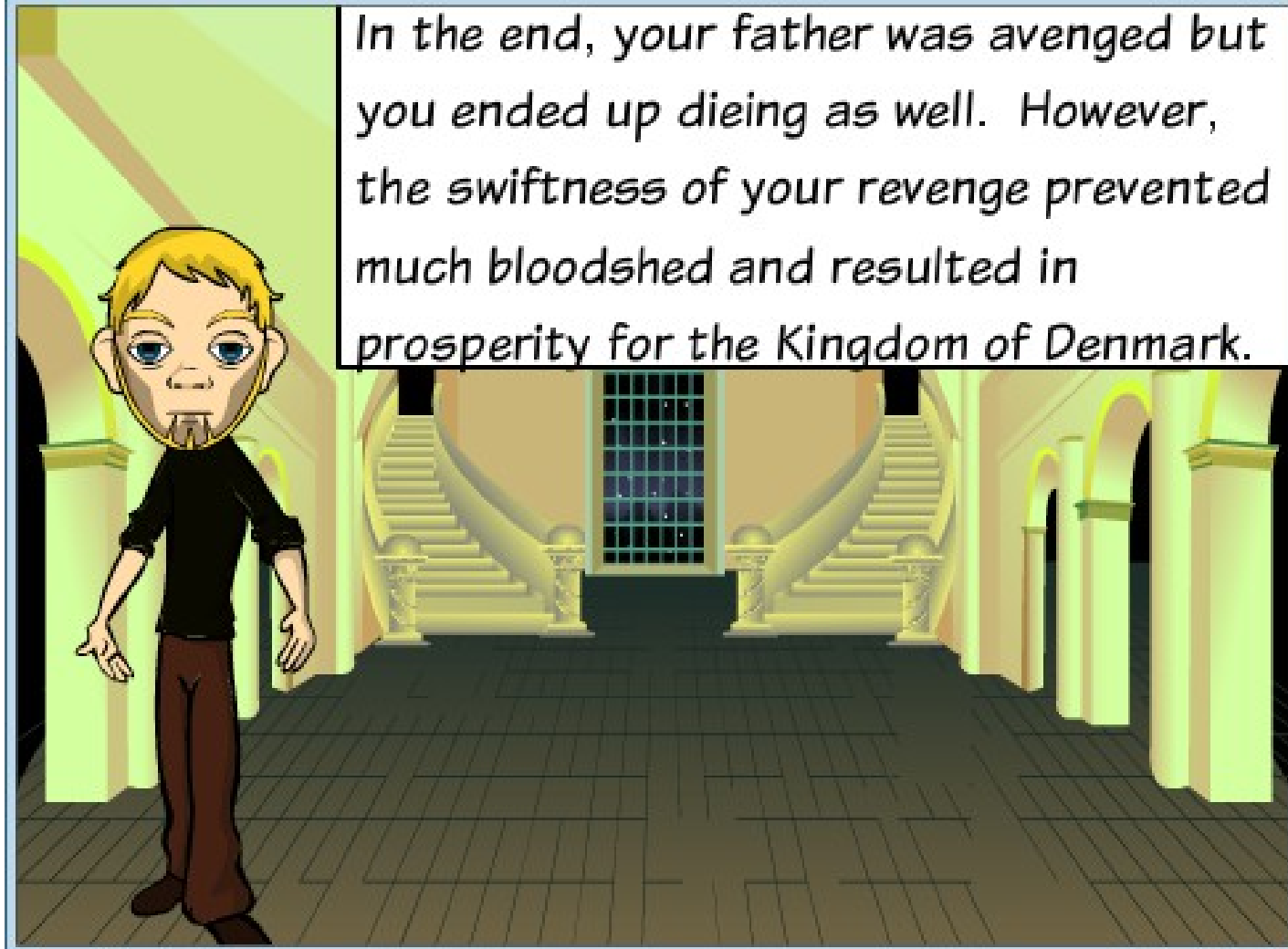
