NEW FRANCE: a Royal Colony

New France

- In 1663, Habitants had colony in <u>Debt and</u> too many <u>attacks</u> were being made <u>on New France</u>.
- King Louis (XIV) takes direct and full control.
 - Absolute Monarchy: a king (monarch)
 who has unlimited power over his
 people, not restricted by any laws/rules.

New France

- In an absolute monarchy:
 - only those selected by king can participate in government.
 - only king makes final decision.
 - King responsible for wellbeing of all.
 - majority rule does not exist. Minority has say.
