Once you have selected your revolution that you will be researching go to:

- 1. <u>https://www.gale.com/covid19access</u>
 - a. Scroll down to "Gale in Context High School" and click on that
- 2. In the search bar:
 - a. Type in your "revolution" press search
 - b. Here you have the results for your topic on this database
- 3. For a primary resource: beside the search bar, click on "advanced search"
 - a. Type in your topic
 - b. Then scroll down to: "by content type"
 - i. Select "Primary source"
 - ii. Select search
 - c. This now includes only references on your topic that are primary resources
