- H herbaceous, cover sparse to 100%, may include scattered shrubs and seedlings < 1 m
- Sy shrubs < 2 m
- Sm shrubs > 2 m
- Cyo cottonwood < 20 m, open canopy
- Cy cottonwood < 20 m, closed canopy
- Cm cottonwood > 20 m, closed canopy
- Cd cottonwood > 20 m, open canopy with shrubs (decadent)
- CS mixed cottonwood and white spruce
- S white spruce
- A cleared, cultivated
