

Lab #10: First Draft of Your Research Presentation Poster

Purpose:

The purpose of today's assignment is for your team to condense your research project into a poster to share your results with others.

Your team task:

- As a team, you will create your research poster which you will be presenting to UBC undergraduate and graduate students, and UBC faculty at the PSYO 270 Research Presentation Conference.
- Each team member must contribute to the poster and the presentation, and thus will be responsible for specific sections of the poster and presentation.

General Guidelines:

- As a team, discuss how you will construct and present your research poster, and how each member of your team will contribute.
- Each team member must have a specific role and must contribute in order to receive credit.
- If a team member is not present today, indicate their anticipated role and communicate with them asap outside of class about what they need to do.
- Ensure you have all the sections on your poster required (as per the LAB_11 document).
- Follow the formatting requirements when you submit your assignment.

Recommendations:

- In order to balance workload and contribution responsibilities across all team members, we have a recommended list of roles (writing for the poster and presenting at the conference):
 - Team Member A: Introduction | Team Member B: Method
Team Member C: Results | Team Member D: Discussion, Strengths, Limitations, Take Home Message
- Follow the LAB_10 documents closely.

Formatting requirements:

- You **MUST** submit the poster-part of this assignment as a **.pdf** document. Your poster may look very different when your professor or graduate co-instructor opens it if it is not a .pdf.

Documents to refer to / Template to use:

Refer to the LAB_10 documents and follow them closely.

At the end of class:

- one member of your team needs to upload your LAB_10 team assignment sheet outlining team member assignments and your poster title as a .odt, .doc, or .pdf file **AND** one member of your team needs to upload a LAB_10 first-draft poster as a **.pdf** file.
- It does not matter which team member uploads your team's assignments.
- Each team member should, though, keep a copy of each document for his/her records.

After class:

- Your professor or graduate co-instructor will provide each member of your team with feedback on your submitted assignment before the next class.
