

Lab #11: Second Draft of Your Research Presentation Poster

Purpose:

The purpose of today's assignment is for your team to further refine your research project poster based on the feedback you received on your first draft from your professor or graduate co-instructor.

Your team task:

- As a team, you will further refine your research poster.
- You change the assignment of responsibilities from your first draft if you need/choose to at this point.

General Guidelines:

- As a team, discuss if you need / want to change how each member of your team will contribute.
- If a team member is not present today, indicate their anticipated role and communicate with them asap outside of class about what they need to do.
- Remember, that each role is responsible for writing that section for the poster and presenting that section at the conference)
- Ensure you have all the sections on your poster required (as per LAB_10 documents) and that you incorporate the feedback you received on your LAB_10 assignment.
- Follow the formatting requirements when you submit your assignment.

Formatting requirements:

- You **MUST** submit the poster-part of this assignment as a **.pdf** document. Your poster may look very different when your professor or graduate co-instructor opens it if it is not a .pdf.

Documents to refer to / Template to use:

Refer to the LAB_10 documents and follow them closely. Refer to the feedback you received on your LAB_11 assignment.

At the end of class:

- one member of your team needs to upload your LAB_11 team assignment sheet as a .odt, .doc, or .pdf file AND one member of your team needs to upload a LAB_11 second-draft poster as a .pdf file.
- It does not matter which team member uploads your team's assignments.
- Each team member should, though, keep a copy of each document for his/her records.

After class:

- Your professor or graduate co-instructor will provide each member of your team with a final round of feedback on your submitted assignment.
- This provides you the opportunity to make after final changes to your poster.
- You MUST submit your FINAL .pdf version of your poster for printing by

the deadline date given to you in class!!! If you miss that deadline date, your poster will not be printed!!

Final posters will be printed Friday-Monday in time for the PSYO 270 Poster Conference.
