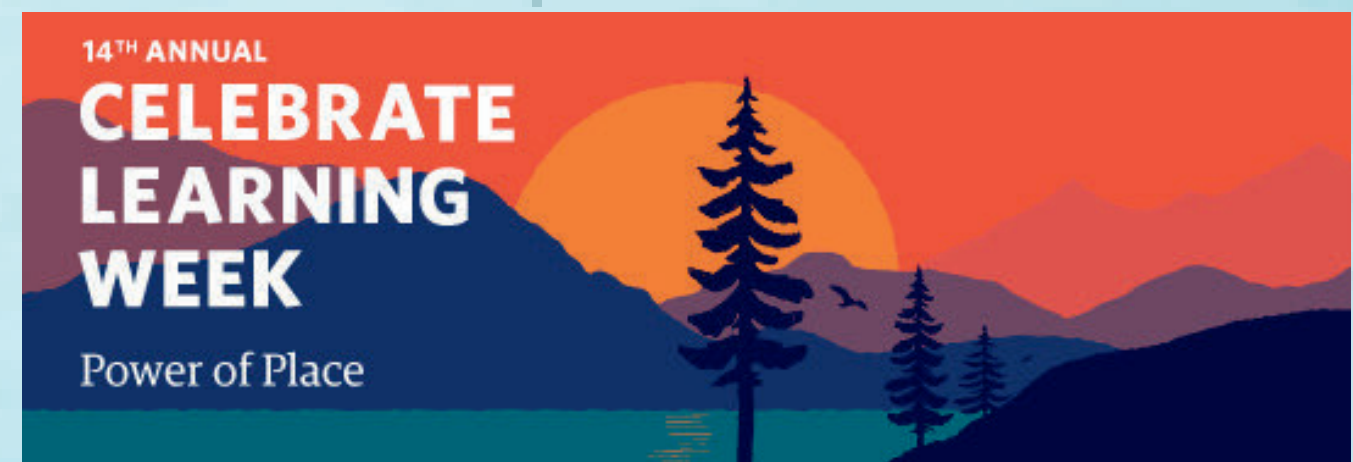
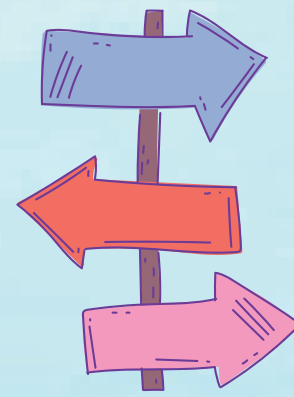
## *CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS*
