Application Information for Summer Programs

Most of the above programs are offered by official exchange partners of the Robert H. Lee Graduate School, Sauder School of Business. UBC MM students, if selected to participate by the RHL Graduate School, do not pay tuition for these programs. Other program fees and expenses are the responsibility of the attending student.

Exchange Partner programs: Requires a 2-step application process. Firstly, UBC MM students need to apply to the RHL Graduate School Office/Go Global. We will review your application, and if approved, nominate you to the selected school. You will then be required to complete paperwork and course selection directly with the school.

Please note: Program Dates and costs can change. All dates and costs to be confirmed by participating students. In cases where there's a date and/or cost discrepancy between this document and the host school program website, the host school information will stand.
