Courses	 Banking and Finance Strategy and Innovation Marketing Management Human Capital Management Course offerings are subject to change each year. Detailed course list and course outline will be released one to two months before the exchange programme starts. 		
Course Load	 Exchange students may select up to a maximum of four full courses, totalling 156 contact hours per trimester. Full course Each course consists of 12 weekly sessions One weekly session = 3.25 contact hours (total 39 contact hours) One written examination on the 13th week Half course Each half course has six weekly seminars 1 weekly session = 3.25 contact hours (total 19.5 contact hours). 1 written examination on the 7th week One full course is equivalent to 2 half courses. Courses that do not require a final examination are assessed 100% on coursework. 		
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Language of Instruction and Requirement	All courses are taught in English. Exchange students should be proficient in English. TOEFL score >100 IBT, if was not the medium of instruction at the undergraduate level.		
Method of Instruction	Our MBA courses are taught in-person and students are required to join us face-to-face. Classes are conducted in seminar style. The average class size is 40. Assessment is based on a combination of methods that may include group project and presentation, class participation, mid-term quiz and/or final examination. The weightage given for each method of assessment varies for different courses. The total weightage is 100%.		
Examination	 The final examination will be held on Full course - the last week of the trimester (week 13) Half course - the sixth or seventh week of the trimester (week 6 or 7) The examination could take in the form of a written paper or a project. The written paper examination must be taken at the specified time. Students must maintain at least 75% class attendance in order to participate in the examination or be graded for non-examinable courses.

Student Pass	Upon arrival in Singapore, exchange students are to call at One Stop @			
otudent r ass	SAC (Student Activities Centre, NS3-01-03 North Spine) to make payment for academic and other expenses.			
	It is advisable for students to arrive before the start of the trimester as they are required to go to the Immigration & Checkpoint Authority Office, Student Pass section, 10 Kallang Road, Singapore 208718, to collect their student passes.			
	If the duration of study at Nanyang Technological University (NTU) is more than six months, exchange students are required to undergo the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) and Tuberculosis (TB) medical tests. The HIV and TB medical tests must be done at the NTU Medical Centre. The issuing of the Student Pass to exchange students by the Immigration & Checkpoint Authority is subject to the passing of the HIV and TB medical tests. Exchange students who fail any of these medical examinations will not be admitted and will be repatriated to their home country at their own cost.			
Orientation	A half day session for all exchange students; usually held on the Frida before the start of each trimester.			
Student Services	The Student Ex-co and the NBS Alumni Association organise a variety of professional development and social activities during the academic year, most of which are open to exchange students.			
	The buddy system ensures exchange students are provided with a buddy to help them settle into the new environment.			
Career Services	The Graduate Studies Career Development Office in the Nanyang Business School organises several recruitment-related activities each year. Services are extended to exchange students on a reciprocal basis.			
Student Life	A young vibrant campus where learning takes place beyond the classroom, lecture theatre, and laboratory. With a truly holistic approach to education, students can look forward to developing their leadership potential and problem-solving ability, and have the opportunity to give back to the community.
