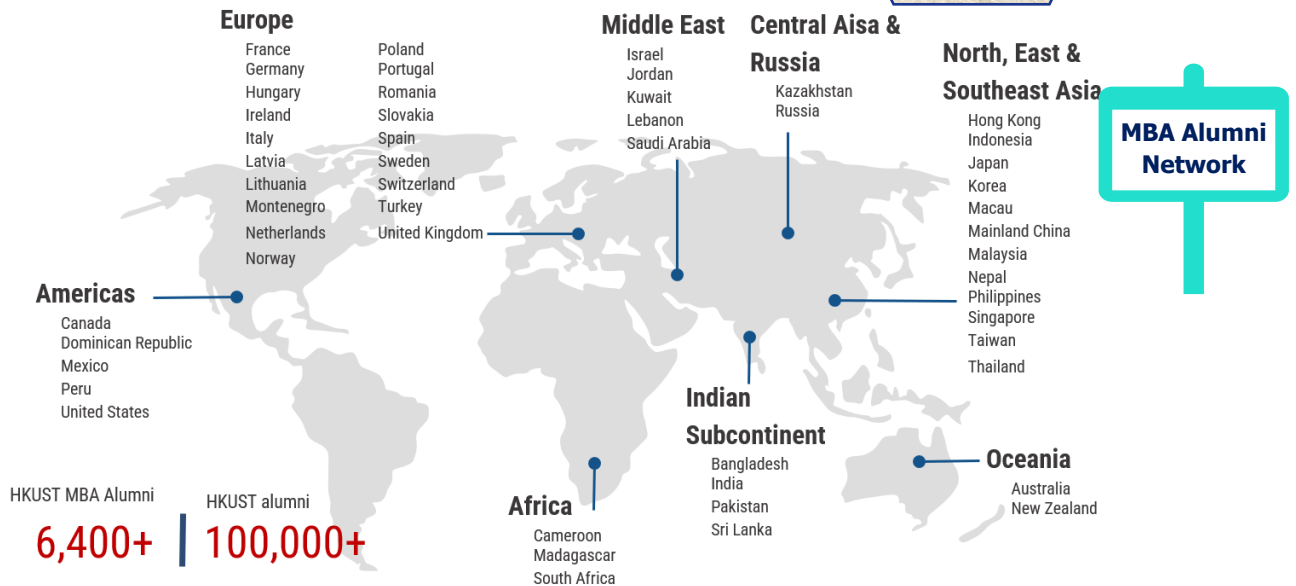

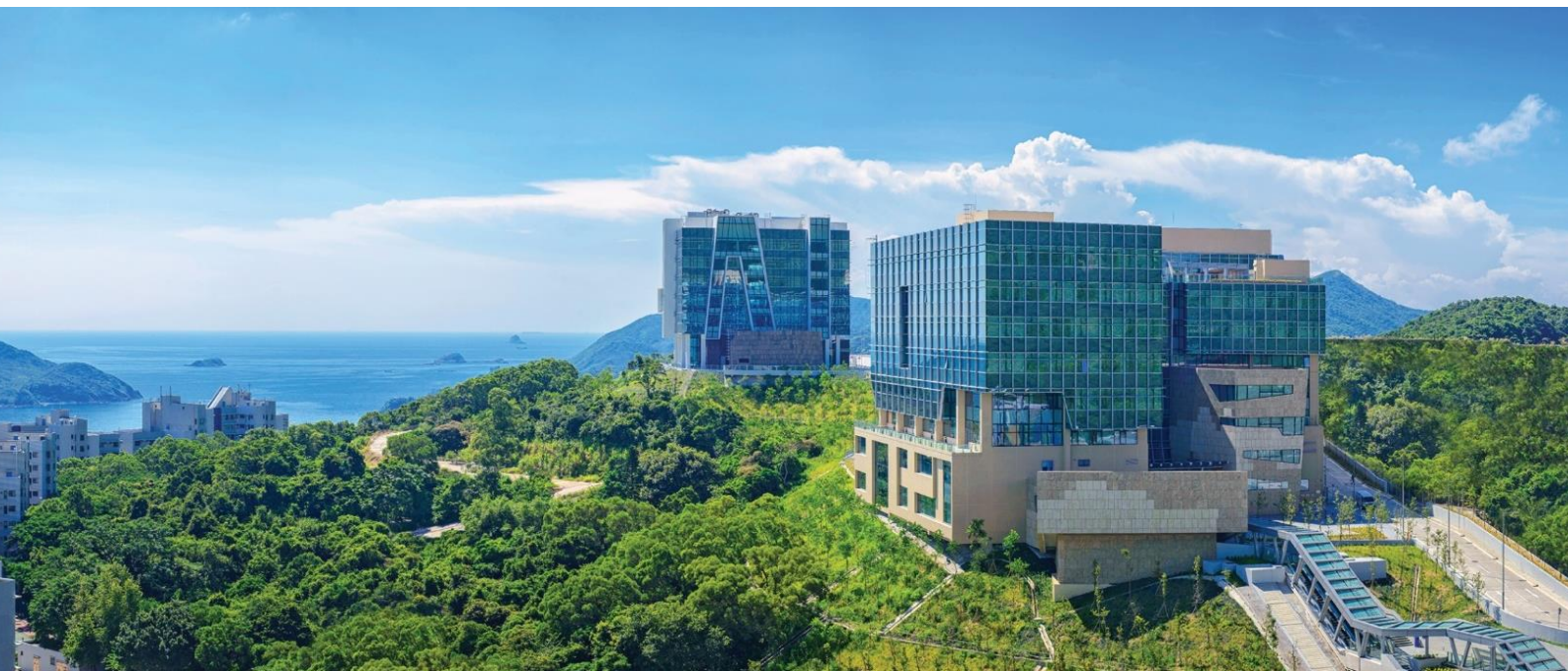

Available Exchange Terms & Timelines (Tentative and subject to changes)

Our **Fall and Spring terms are divided into two half-terms (1st & 2nd)**, providing exchange student with the flexibility to choose between an 8-week Half-Term or a 16-week Full-Term exchange.

Once registered successfully in the program, students are required to arrive in Hong Kong before the term begins and complete self-enrolment of courses on the University's online system. All course quotas are on a first-come-first-served basis.

In-person Exchange

Nominated students will receive the details and guidance from our team in each stage



A. STUDENT VISA

Student visas will be required for all full-time and in-person incoming exchange students **without the right of abode in Hong Kong** (i.e. non-Hong Kong citizens). Please let us know in advance if your circumstances are different.

Students will need to courier the visa application materials to the MBA Office. It may take **up to 2 months** for visa approval by the HKSAR's Immigration Department. Upon approval, students will be notified to download the e-visa label.

Mainland Chinese students holding PRC passports will need an additional 2-4 weeks to apply for an EEP (往來港澳通行證) and relevant exit endorsement (赴港簽注) on their own after the visa label is approved.

B. COMPULSORY HKUST TRAVEL INSURANCE

The University policy stipulates that all postgraduate studies, including exchange-in students, are required to subscribe to the [HKUST Compulsory Travel Insurance Plan](#), **on a mandatory basis**, at least one month before the commencement date of the exchange period.

Please check the [Application Form](#) and [Coverage](#) of the HKUST Compulsory Travel Insurance Plan. Your insurance coverage must include the whole study period.

C. OFF-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

The on-campus hall is not available for short-term exchange students due to the limited supply. Students are strongly recommended to visit the off-campus accommodation before signing a lease. A Housing Guide can be found at [Off-Campus Housing](#).

Elective classes will take place either on the Clearwater Bay campus (normally on weekends) or in downtown areas such as Central (on weekday evenings). Here are some recommended locations to consider for your accommodation.

D. PRE-ARRIVAL - COMMUNICATION GROUP AND ONLINE ORIENTATION

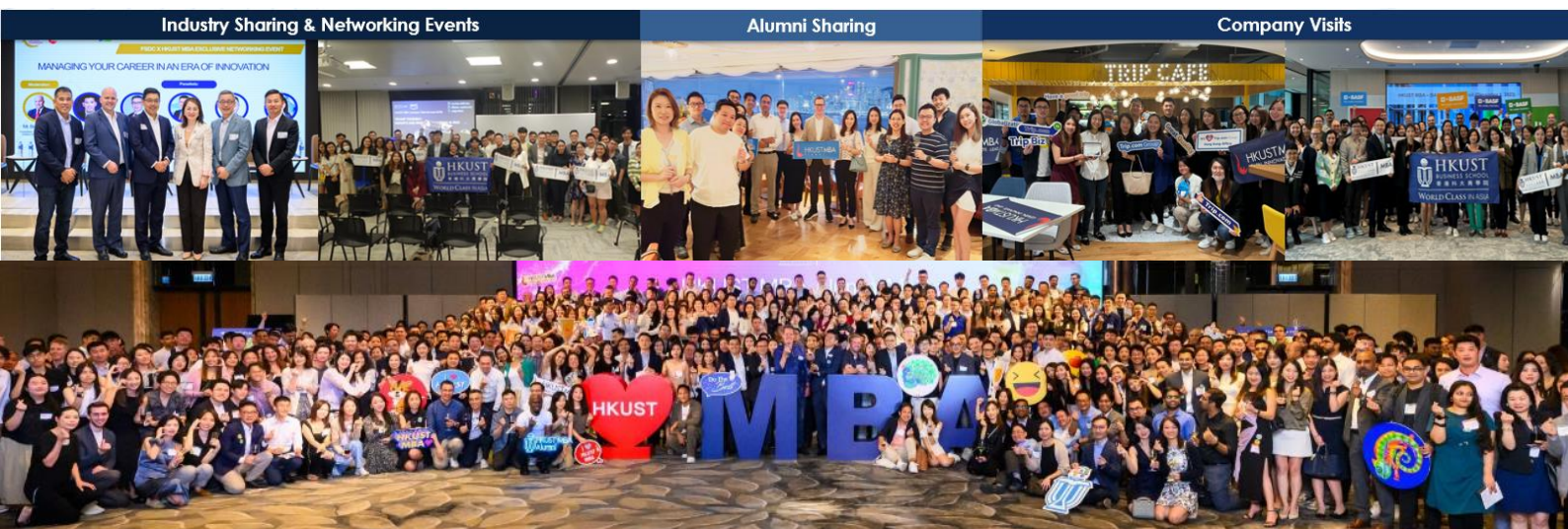
A communication group will be created through a mobile app to help you connect with other HKUST MBA exchange students. You can also find potential accommodation partners in Hong Kong in the group.

Class Formats	Lectures, computer simulations, case discussions, individual and group projects and presentations, supplemented by industry speaker-sharing sessions.
Attendance Policies	<p>Class attendance is mandatory. Select your courses carefully and enroll only if you can commit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Missing 25% of the classes will result in a grade deduction. • Missing more than 25% of a course will result in a “Fail” grade or withdrawal. • Some courses may require 100% class attendance.
Assessments	Exams (usually in the last week of the course, if any), projects and presentations, assignments, class work and participation, etc.
Study Loads & Options	<p>8 Credits will be granted by default for MBA elective course enrolment regardless of the exchange period. You will automatically receive 8 credits for enrolling in MBA elective courses, regardless of the exchange period.</p> <p>Core and language courses are NOT available for exchange students.</p>
Credit Overloading	If you require more than 8 HKUST credits to meet your home school requirements or graduation needs, requests must be made through the home school coordinator with the HKUST MBA Office. Approval is not guaranteed.

C. COURSE GRADING & TRANSCRIPT

An e-transcript will normally be sent to your home school's coordinator via email around 1.5 months after the completion of the exchange term.

For courses graded with "Pass/Fail", please note that no Letter Grade will be shown on your HKUST transcript. You are strongly recommended to check with your home school if it will affect your exchange credit transfer before course registration.

A. CAREER RESOURCES

Exchange students have access to the online MBA job board and career resources, such as Bloomberg Terminals. You will be invited to participate in selected corporate events organized by the HKUST MBA Career & Professional Development Team.

Additionally, the HKUST Career Centre hosts a variety of career events throughout the year, including recruitment talks and Career Mosaic, which showcases local, regional, and international employers interested in hiring HKUST undergraduate and postgraduate students, including MBA candidates.

Generally, non-local exchange students holding a study visa for a specific exchange term at HKUST are not eligible to work in Hong Kong. For more information, please consult the guidelines provided by the HK Immigration Department (see Q23 on the IMMD FAQ - [LINK](#)).

Please note that one-on-one coaching and career workshops are not available for exchange students. While MBA exchange students are considered to be HKUST MBA alumni, they do not hold university-level alumni status at HKUST.
