




A RESOURCE BLOG

How do we evaluate resources for selection and curation? We want to save time (and money). Having a five finger rule (mnemonic device) can aid in this.






Have a look at these sites and attempt to develop a 5 finger rules for evaluation.

- Reliability
 - -Corroborated Source? Double checked...; checking domain (easywhois.com)
 - Bias/objectivity
 - -Accuracy
- Accessibility
 - -Appropriate reading level, graphics
- · Relevance content
- · Organization of content FAQ; design; user friendly
- Advertising (chrome plug in to block adblocker extension; <u>disconnect.me</u> extension - eliminates tracking cookies etc)



MY SRL and PLTech's co-created 5 finger selection criteria Feb.25,2014



Cathy Shrock's criteria – just one way to assess. May be of more use to have your own set of criteria (as we've begun today). This may be of use to your students perhaps?
