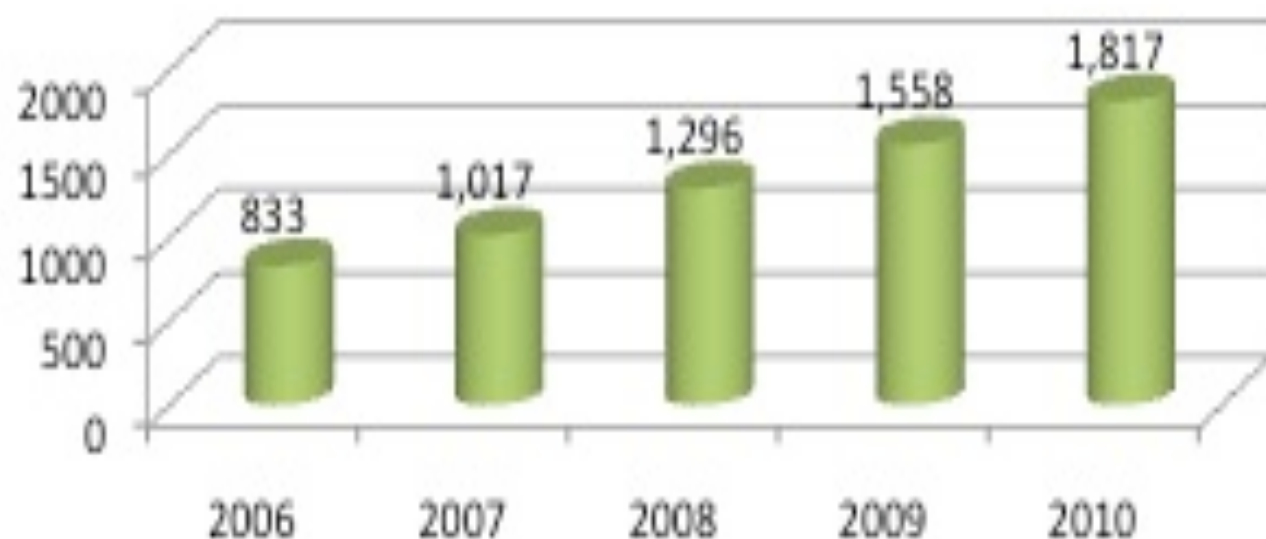

## Jan. – March 2011

- Bielefeld Academic Search Engine: 25.5 million documents – average daily growth > 6,000 items
- Mendeley – articles available for free: 800,000; growth this quarter – over 500,000

# Mostly future uses of institutional repositories?

- Author's works
  - CV for tenure & promotion, grant proposals?
- Students:
  - What has my professor published?
  - What did other students in this class /program do?
  - Deciding where to study: what research have they done there?
- University: campus promotion, web traffic
- Journalists

# Future of institutional repositories?

- What about informal publications, discussions, adding new material to existing documents?
- Research data – stats, interview recordings, music, films?
- Weekly news update (e-mail, website, RSS) – what's new in the IR for your department?
- Permissions / policies for automatic bulk deposit
- Seek forgiveness rather than permission
