
With early parchments, Papyrus, starting in Egypt, this new form of textile swept the globe, transformed into machinery, and unified educators








Johannes Gutenberg




A German inventor,







## PAPER, A TOOL OF COLONIZATION


- Accessible, uniform tool of communication

- Allowed for long-term clarity and storage of ideas and understandings.









#### CLOUD STORAGE




