


The Wealth (and Population) of Nations

GDP per Capita is a nation's total Gross Domestric Product (in US dollars) divided by its total population to provide GDP amount per person, presented as five colour classes. Total GDP (in trillions of US dollars) is represented with the green bar and ranges from under one million for three nations to \$15.09 trillon for the US (shown in legend). Total POPULATION in billions is depicted with the orange bar and ranges from less than 1.000 for five nations to 1.34 billion people in China (shown in legend).
