





- How do we best teach something that has no consensus of agreed definition?




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### The ethical basis of teaching spirituality

- Should nursing be taught from a secular position?
- Students in the paper reported uncertainty about being instructed in spiritual matters. Would our students likely report the similar concerns?



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### The ethical basis of teaching spirituality

- Should nurse education imply spiritual ethical principles of "right" and "wrong?"
- Problem: if we do so, how do we select which values to teach?
