Experience:

You did a great job describing what each experience entails by listing them down in a concise manner. The writing quality here is solid and requires no major revisions.

Education:

This section contains all the required information. No major revision needed.

Volunteer Experience:

You included two volunteer experiences. Each volunteer experience is followed by a description of activities that were carried out. You did a good job including the duration (number of years) that you volunteered for. This is particularly important because it shows your level of commitment.

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Organization:

Formatting for each section looks professional. You included an appropriate amount of information. Any extra information would have been too much and any less would have made it harder for readers to understand.
