

**BYLAW AMENDMENTS
TO ADD SEATS FOR
INTERNATIONAL AND INDIGENOUS STUDENTS**

TO: Council
FROM: Code and Policies Committee
January 15, 2005

The Code and Policies Committee favours adding the two new seats to Council without creating new Constituencies. The Committee also favours submitting each new seat proposal as a separate question.

The first bylaw amendment would be as follows:

(Additions are indicated by *bold italics*).

Bylaw 5

...

2. Members

- (a) The voting members of Council shall be:
- i) the Executive of Council as outlined in Bylaw 5(3)(a);
 - ii) the student representatives of the Board of Governors as defined by the *University Act*;
 - iii) the Council Senators elected in accordance with Bylaw 6(5)(a);
 - iv) ***one indigenous, aboriginal, or First Nations representative, elected by and from the active members of the Society who identify themselves as indigenous, aboriginal, or First Nations;*** and
 - v) the duly elected representatives of the following Constituencies provided that such representatives are elected in accordance with the constitution of the Constituency:
 - (1) Agriculture
 - (2) Architecture
 - (3) Arts
 - (4) Commerce
 - (5) Dentistry
 - (6) Education
 - (7) Engineering
 - (8) Family & Nutritional Science
 - (9) Forestry
 - (10) Graduate Studies
 - (11) Human Kinetics
 - (12) Law
 - (13) Library, Archival & Information Studies
 - (14) Medicine
 - (15) Nursing
 - (16) Pharmacy
 - (17) Planning
 - (18) Rehabilitation Medicine
 - (19) Science
 - (20) Social Work

and all duly elected representatives of other degree granting faculties and schools of the University. Should the name of a Constituency change, such change of name shall not affect the representation of such Constituency, and this provision of the By-Law shall be deemed automatically amended to refer to the new name of the Constituency.
