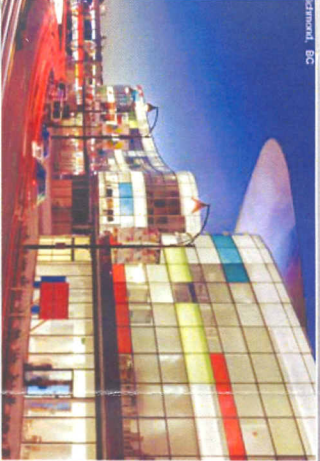

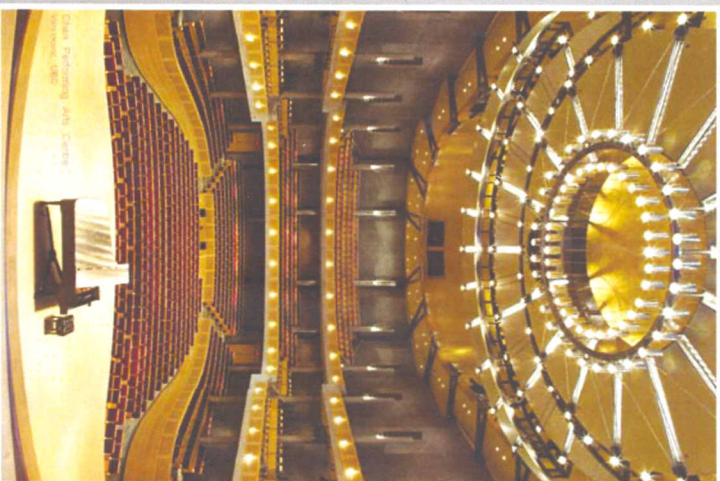
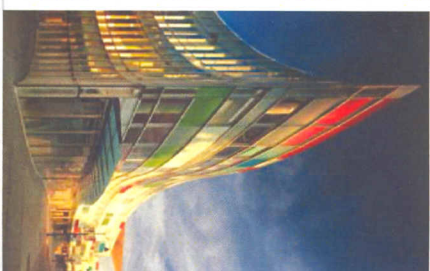
Sustainability:
