Ideas and Interest

• Wuxia (Martial Arts Fantasy fiction)

"One-armed heroes riding a condor, an ageless heroine sleeping on a rope, alcoholic beggars kicking ass, myriad poisonings, doppelgangers of dowagers, and coveted manuscripts – wuxia or martial arts fantasy fiction is the punk rock of Chinese lit genres. Banned for promoting anti-gov sentiment and violent anarchy during the Republican era in China, the genre's practitioners fled to Hong Kong and Taiwan where the form melded with film and blossomed into such a popular phenomena that it has since been re-adopted by the state and re-purposed as a tool for nationalist propoganda." It was one of his points of connection to chinese culture during his formative years. • Identity and national history • Traditional conflated with contemporary (as seen in combining forms such as Song dynasty scrolls and contemporary

• Surrealism • Fear -

"I'm interested in fear and it's relationship to creativity, imagination, child-rearing, the absurd and it's historic role in Asian cultures contrasted with its modern day manifestation." Use of myths, stories, to discipline through fear from his parent in early years.
