

Term	Definition	Who is responsible for developing the objectives/outcomes?
Session Objectives	A specific statement of knowledge, skills and/or attitudes to be acquired or to promote higher forms of thinking in specific and measurable terms that describes what the learner will know or be able to do as a result of engaging in a learning activity.	Week lead in collaboration with lecturer/facilitator
Week Objectives	A specific statement of knowledge, skill, and/or attitude to be acquired through completion of a curricular unit.	Week Leads in collaboration with System and Theme Leads
System	A group of organs or functional collections of tissue that work together to the maintain homeostasis. A system does not work in isolation, and the well-being of the person depends upon the well-being of all the interacting systems.	System Lead
Theme	A specific area or category of knowledge, skills, and attitudes that support undergraduate medical education at UBC.	Theme Lead
Course Outcome	A statement describing significant and essential knowledge, skill, and/or attitude achieved through completion of a course and can be reliably demonstrated.	Course Leads
Year 2 Milestones	An indicator of step-wise progression towards the achievement of a competency.	MDUP
Exit competency	A set of demonstrated competencies and abilities written as a global educational statement and required to be granted a graduate degree.	MDUP –Medical Doctor Undergraduate Program
