On June 5th, 2011, UBC graduate student Rumana Monzur was brutally attacked by her husband who caused permanent loss of her eyesight. Rumana had just gotten back home in Bangladesh to visit her family, including her 5-year-old daughter. She was planning on returning to Vancouver to finish her Master's degree, and looked at the possibility of pursuing further studies.

Rumana's husband has been arrested and has confessed to the "premeditated" assault, but there seem to be attempts to evade justice on his part. We, the St. John's College community (where Rumana used to live when in Canada) and the Bangladeshi Student Association invite you all to join our peaceful rally in support of Rumana, and all other women who have been, and are being subjected to domestic violence. All we demand is **justice for Rumana and an end to violence against women**.
