
## **Comparing Dwelling Affordability Between Vancouver & Montréal**

The Median Multiple is a consistent indicator for measuring housing affordability, calculated by dividing dwelling cost by household income. A Median Multiple 3.0 & Under is considered to be affordable, while 3.1 to 4.0, 4.1 to 5.0, and 5.0 & Over are considered moderately, seriously, and severely affordable respectively.
