

## HOW TO CLEAN IN BETWEEN YOUR TEETH

## A. <u>Floss</u>

- 1. Get an arm's length piece of floss.
- 2. Wrap the floss around your middle fingers.
- 3. Put the floss in between two teeth.
- 4. Wiggle the floss back and forth and push down with your second fingers .
- Wrap the floss around one tooth, making a "c" shape.







- Move the floss to the opposite tooth and repeat.
- 8. Wrap the floss you just used onto one middle finger.
- 9. Repeat for all teeth. Throw out the floss when you are done.



## B. Floss Picks

- Use the pointed tip to get into bigger spaces between the teeth. Be gentle, or else you will hurt your gums.
- Use the floss for softer pieces of food in tighter spaces.
- Wiggle the floss pick gently between two teeth. Slowly move to the gums.
- Hug the floss on the side of the tooth. Gently move the floss back and forth the side of the tooth.
- 5. Move to the other side of the tooth to clean that side.
- 6. Repeat for all teeth.
- 7. You can throw these away each time.

## C. Soft Pick

- 1. Use only for bigger spaces between teeth.
- 2. The tip bends easily to reach all teeth.
- 3. Gently slide the tip between teeth.
- 4. Slide the brush slowly in and out to clean.
- 5. Repeat on all teeth.
- 6. Throw it away each time after using.
